Learning and teaching

To update the curriculum documents and teaching and learning materials of the following subjects with the elements of National Security Education according to the guidelines set by the Education Bureau: Chinese Language, Technology education, BAFS, Information and Communication Technology, Integrated Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics and Geography.

Three inspections on learning and teaching materials were done on 6 October 2021, 15 November 2021 and 19 May 2022. The learning and teaching materials were saved in the server for inspection from time to time.

To promote students' learning on Chinese culture related to National Security, our school held a meaningful activity in the morning assembly on 13 December 2021: 「銘記歷史・珍愛和平」南京大屠殺 84 周年學校悼念活動.

In addition to displaying the national flag on each school day, our school held flag-raising ceremony every Monday so as to promote national education, help students develop a sense of belonging to the country, an affection for the Chinese people and enhance their sense of national identity and help students "鞏固價值觀 培育家國情" as mentioned by Mr. Kelvin Yeung Yun-hung, JP, Secretary for Education on 26 August 2021 (https://www.edb.gov.hk/tc/aboutedb/press/insiderperspective/insiderperspective 20210826.html).

Peer lesson observation was enforced by Heads of Departments and monitored by Staff Development Committee. Teachers were asked to study how the elements of National Security Education are actively and appropriately included in daily lessons.

For quality assurance on the implementation of National Security Education, teaching and learning materials were saved in the school server that was accessible by teachers of the same subjects, senior teachers, Assistant Principals, Vice Principals and Principal. This helps promote the professional exchange of the teaching strategies applied in the lessons of National Security Education.

The display of the national flag on each school day and flag-raising ceremony significantly promoted students' sense of belonging to the country and affection for the Chinese people. It is important that these activities should be continued in coming school years.

The pedagogies on how to effectively promote students' learning of National Security Education have to be further studied. Educational research on this area could be an important reference. Lesson observation exercise could be adopted as one of the tools to promote professional exchange about the pedagogies concerned among teachers.

To promote exchange between our school and other schools in China, support from EDB could be sought. It

In S.1, the topic of "中國與我、同心耀香江" was included. In S.2, the topic of identity of being a Chinese was elaborated. It was "誰是香港人". To strengthen harmonious relationship with people both in China and Hong Kong, the topic of "她來自中國、香港的兄弟姊妹" was included. Our goal setting exercise aimed to motivate students to learn and help them build up strong and responsible attitude to face their daily problems and develop skills to solve the problems. Many negative indicators marked by students on some issues can help teachers identify the students who might have problems related to their daily life. The students will then be followed up by Class Teachers, Student Discipline Committee and Counselling Committee.	Our school actively promoted students' knowledge on Chinese culture. Students were encouraged to build up positive understanding on social relationship with others including those coming from low-income groups and people of different cultures and countries. More importantly, our students were encouraged to build up close relationship with people from China and develop care for others. In general, our students had developed the sense of respect and law-abiding attitude.
